What Constitutes Sexual Assault?

Sexual assault is a crime! It is defined as intentional sexual contact, characterized by use of force, threats, intimidation, abuse of authority, or when the victim does not or cannot consent. Sexual assault includes the following:

- **Rape**
- **Forcible sodomy (i.e., oral or anal sex)**
- **Unwanted sexual contact that is aggravated, abusive, or wrongful**
- **Unwanted and inappropriate sexual contact**
- **Sexual assault can occur without regard to gender, spousal relationship or age of the victim.**
