GREEN (pg. 73) ⁶	HEAR: ALARM GREEN ⁴ SEE: GREEN FLAG	ATTACK IS NOT PROBABLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MOPP 0 or as directed ^{1,3} • Normal Wartime Condition • Resume operations • Continue recovery actions
YELLOW (pg. 75) ⁶	HEAR: ALARM YELLOW ⁴ SEE: YELLOW FLAG	ATTACK IS PROBABLE IN LESS THAN 30 MINUTES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MOPP 2 or as directed protection with overhead cover ^{1,2} • Protect and cover assets • Go to protective shelter or seek best protection with overhead cover ²
BLUE (pg. 89) ⁶	HEAR: SIREN (WAVERING TONE) ⁵ SEE: BLUE FLAG	AIR / MSL ATTACK IS IMMINENT OR IN PROGRESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seek immediate protection with overhead cover • MOPP 4 or as directed ¹ • Report observed/unobserved attacks (SALUTE)
	HEAR: SIREN (WOOP TONE) ⁵ SEE: BLUE FLAG	INDIRECT FIRE (IDF) ATTACK IS IMMINENT OR IN PROGRESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediately lay face down/take cover and protect eyes and ears • Two mins after last known explosion, move to cover while surveying area for UXOs and injured personnel. • Since IDF can also accompany a ground attack, be prepared to subsequently accomplish Ground Attack General Actions below.
	HEAR: BUGLE (CALL-TO-ARMS) ⁵ SEE: BLUE FLAG	GROUND ATTACK IS IMMINENT OR IN PROGRESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take immediate cover ^{2,3} • MOPP 4 or as directed ¹ • Defend self and position • Report observed/unobserved attacks (SALUTE)
BLACK (pg. 124) ⁶	HEAR: SIREN (STEADY TONE) ⁵ SEE: BLACK FLAG	ATTACK IS OVER AND CBRN CONTAMINATION AND/OR UXO HAZARDS ARE SUSPECTED OR PRESENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MOPP 4 or as directed ^{1,3} • Perform self-aid/buddy care • Remain under overhead cover or within a shelter until directed • Initial Release: Specialized teams (CBRN RECON/ADAT) as directed • Limited Release: Unit PAR teams as directed • General Release: Mission Essential Personnel as directed • There will be no shift change during Alarm Black

NOTES:

1. Wear field gear and personal body armor (if issued) when outdoors or when directed.
2. Commanders may direct mission essential tasks or functions to continue at increased risk.
3. This alarm condition may be applied to an entire installation or individual chemical zones.
4. Alarm Condition will be followed by voice announcement of "MOPP Level, ZONE(S) Affected."
5. Siren will be followed by voice announcement of "ALARM Condition, Type of Attack, MOPP Level, ZONE(S) Affected."
