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This instruction implements AFD 40-1, *Health Promotion*. It describes the proper completion and submission of 59th Medical Wing (MDW) Form 2510, *Lackland Behavioral Questionnaire*. This instruction applies to all personnel assigned, attached or under contract to the 59th Medical Wing. This instruction does not apply to the Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve. This publication requires the collection and/or maintenance of information protected by the Privacy Act of 1974 authorized by 10 U.S.C. 55, *Medical and Dental Care*, and E.O. 9397 (SSN). Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility using the AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*. Requests for waivers must be submitted to the OPR listed above for consideration and approval. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with in accordance with (IAW) Air Force Manual 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of IAW Air Force Records Information Management System Records Disposition Schedule.

**1. Overview.** The purpose of the 59 MDW Form 2510 is to identify individuals with behavioral or mental health issues. Trainees who report the most significant problems on the questionnaire are seen for a follow-up interview.

**2. Personnel Responsibilities.** The screening questionnaire will be administered by 559 MDOS/SGPL, Psychology Research Service, to all recruits. Completing the 59 MDW Form 2510 is mandatory for all basic military training trainees and occurs during the first 72 hours of in-processing.

**3. Forms Submission.** Completed 59 MDW Form 2510s are retained by 559 MDOS/SGPL as part of the Biographical Evaluation and Screening of Trainees Program.
