

WHASC SPILL RESPONSE (Code Orange)

DID SOMETHING
SPILL?

INCIDENTAL

(Level 1 Spill)

(1) No harm to personnel (injury or illness) will result from exposure to spill material AND
(2) Material spilled can be cleaned by shop personnel

1. **CONTAIN** and/or control the release
2. **CLEAN** up the release using proper absorbent media for the chemical spilled
3. **DISPOSE** of the spilled material and contaminated absorbent properly by following the procedures recommended on the MSDS and method described in the LAFB Hazardous Waste Management Plan

5. **CALL the Medical Control Center 210-292-5990**

- a. Name, office symbol and your phone number
- b. Organization (office symbol) responsible for the release (point of contact and phone number)
- c. Date, time and location of the release (be specific).
- d. Name, stock number, manufacturer and amount of chemical material spilled;
- e. Source and cause of spill
- f. Environment the spill entered (ground, air, water, sewer line, confined with Bldg)
- g. Clean-up action taken and amount of material recovered

6. **FOLLOW** internal operating instructions for waste disposal

WHASC HAZMAT 210-292-9469

EMERGENCY

(Level 2 or 3 Spill)

(1) Injury or illness of personnel will result from exposure to spilled material OR
(2) HAZMAT response team must clean-up

1. **CALL 911** immediately to report and provide the following information to the dispatcher:

- a. Name, stock number, manufacturer, and amount of chemical material spilled;
- b. Location of release (be specific – Bldg #, Door #, Column)
- c. Name, office symbol, and phone number of the individual reporting the release
- d. Number of personnel injured, if any and/or if known
- e. Other information requested by the dispatcher

2. **EVACUATE** to an area upwind of the spill and conduct an employee roll call (if safe and time permits shut down their operations/secure equipment

3. **CALL the Medical Control Center 210-292-5990**

4. **CONTAIN** the release, ONLY if measures can be performed SAFELY

5. **INFORM** the supervisor, Zone Master or Chief, and Environmental

6. **REPORT** to the Senior Fire Office on the scene and assist as necessary

7. **ASSIST** with post-emergency clean-up as directed by Environmental

8. **FOLLOW** internal operating instructions for waste disposal
