OPSEC Steps

- 1 – *ID Critical Information*
- 2 – *Analyze Threats*
- 3 – *Analyze Vulnerabilities*
- 4 – *Assess Risk*
- 5 – *Apply OPSEC Measures*

Operations Security (OPSEC) - *an analytical process used to deny our adversaries unclassified – but sensitive - information concerning our intentions and capabilities by identifying, controlling, and protecting indicators associated with our planning processes or operations.*

Apply OPSEC to:

-Military Operations – Personal Activities –Professional Activities
