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This supplement implements and extends the guidance of AFI 11-2C-17, Volume 2, *C-17 Aircrew Evaluation Criteria*, 19 April 2005. With the exception of the Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) Associate Program, this instruction does not apply to AFRC. This instruction does not apply to the Air National Guard (ANG). Units may supplement this instruction and will coordinate supplements with AETC/A3V before approval. Submit suggested improvements to this publication on AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*, through standardization and evaluation (Stan/Eval) channels, to AETC/A3V. See Attachment 1 for a glossary of references and supporting information. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with AFMAN 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS). The authorities to waive wing/unit level requirements in this publication are identified with a Tier ("T-0, T-1, T-2, T-3") number following the compliance statement. See AFI 33-360, *Publications and Forms Management*, for a description of the authorities associated with the Tier numbers. Submit requests for waivers through the chain of command to the appropriate Tier waiver approval authority, or alternately, to the Publication OPR for non-tiered compliance items publications. This publication may be supplemented at any level, but all direct Supplements must be routed to the OPR of this publication for coordination prior to certification and approval.

1.4. Deviations and Waivers. Report deviations or exceptions without waiver through command channels to AETC/A3V. AETC/A3V will notify AMC/A3V.

1.4.1. AETC/A2/3/10 is the waiver authority for contents of the basic instruction and this supplement.

1.4.2. AETC/A2/3/10 will forward a copy of long-term waivers to this instruction to HQ AMC/A3VK for follow-on action, if required.

1.5.3. Local Procedures Coordination. Units send a copy of local supplements to AETC/A3V for coordination. (T-2) AETC/A3V will send a final copy of unit supplement to AMC/A3V.

1.7. Improvement Recommendations. Send comments and suggested improvements to this instruction on AF Form 847 through Stan/Eval channels to AETC/A3VO.

1.9.5. Spot Evaluations. Refer to AFI 11-202V2 AETC Supplement for spot and no-notice evaluation requirements.

1.15.2. AETC units will not supplement the open-book exam.
