**DRESS AND PERSONAL APPEARANCE  
OF AIR FORCE PERSONNEL**

**COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY**

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This instruction supplements Air Force Instruction (AFI) 36-2903, *Dress and Personal Appearance of Air Force Personnel*. This supplement is designating no-hat and no-salute areas, additional information on organizational clothing requirements, and the physical training uniform. It applies to all active duty, guard, and reserve Air Force members while stationed at Edwards Air Force Base. This publication may not be supplemented or further implemented/extended. Requests for waivers must be submitted through the chain of command to the appropriate Tier waiver approval authority. This supplement does not apply to Civil Air Patrol. See Attachment 1 for a glossary of references and supporting information. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained IAW Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of IAW Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS). Refer Recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) using the AF IMT 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route AF IMT 847s from the field through the appropriate functional's chain of command.

1.1. Commanders and first sergeants have the responsibility to address appearance concerns which are not specifically referenced in this supplement or the basic instruction. Specific areas of base-wide concern will be elevated through the chain of command to the Installation Commander for resolution, then uniformly enforced throughout Edwards AFB.

**2.1. No-Hat Required/No-Salute Areas.**

2.1.1. **(Added)** Walkway between Building 1 and Court House.

2.1.2. **(Added)** Areas on the aircraft side of the flight line fence.

2.1.3. **(Added)** Walkway between Building 1806 and flightline Entry Control Point (ECP).

2.1.4. **(Added)** Fenced in portion of the Avionics Test and Integration Complex (ATIC).

2.1.5. **(Added)** Fenced in portion of South Base munition storage area and area north of building 605.

2.1.6. **(Added)** Fenced in portions of Building 3522 and 3522A while conducting military working dog training.

2.1.7. **(Added)** Eagle's Nest, back patio and pool side of Club Muroc.

2.1.8. **(Added)** Inside the fence of the Civil Engineering Explosive Ordnance Disposal Branch compound and proficiency range area while performing official duties.

**9.1. Organizational Clothing and Equipment.**

9.1.1. **(Added)** Sage Green or Black Watchcap. The watchcap is authorized for wear with ABU outer garments or the physical training uniform (PTU).

9.1.2. **(Added)** Airman Leadership School students are authorized to wear the white rope for graduation only with the Semi Formal or Mess Dress uniform.

9.1.3. **(Added)** Reflective belts or vests are authorized for use in uniform for safety purposes.

9.1.4. **(Added)** When wearing the Flightsuit, wear the AFTC, 412 TW, Test Pilot School (or service equivalent), or USAF Weapons School (or service equivalent) emblem on the left shoulder.

9.1.5. **(Added)** Paramedic Ambulance Service (PAS) clothing requirements. PAS assigned military personnel are authorized to wear the coverall jumpsuit while performing medical tasks in their primary duties of assignment. Table 9.1, Uniform Style Limitations and Requirements, identifies uniform style limitations and requirements for the Edwards AFB PAS after normal duty hours, weekends, and holidays only.

**Table 9.1. (Added) Uniform Style Limitations and Requirements**

Coverall jumpsuit	Must wear the designated blue coverall jumpsuit with reflective tape around sleeves and distal pant legs. Sleeves will be worn down or rolled up past the forearms within 1 inch of the elbows. The jumpsuit will be professionally worn and not excessively loose or tight.
Hat	Must wear the ABU hat. Exception: Hats are not required during an emergency response, while performing emergency care or in other designated no-hat areas as outlined in Para 2.1
Shirt	Must wear PTU or the sand colored ABU undershirt or sweatshirt underneath the jumpsuit.
Boots	Boots will be worn IAW AFI 36-2903. Boots will be clean, dry and serviceable.
Nametag	Must wear Velcro nametag with name, rank and service identified

**7.1. Physical Training Uniform**

7.1.7.1. Wear of an optional solid black or dark blue baseball/sport cap with the Air Force symbol or U.S. Air Force printed/embroidered on the front during organized PT is authorized. Caps are to be worn outdoors only.
