

PRIMARY IG ISSUES

REPRISAL

No person may prohibit an AF member from making a lawful communication or take an unfavorable personnel action or withhold a favorable personnel action as a reprisal against a member for making or preparing to make a protected disclosure.

RESTRICTION

Restriction defined—Preventing or attempting to prevent a member of the Armed Forces from making or preparing a lawful communication to Members of Congress and/or an IG.

FRAUD, WASTE, AND ABUSE

Safeguard and monitor resources for potential threats and misuse. FWA reduces combat capability and detracts from the professional image of America's Armed Forces. If you see it, report it!

THE ROLE OF THE IG

- Provide a fair and credible system for processing complaints
 - Impartial fact-finding
 - Trained, experienced investigators
 - Unbiased personnel
- Single POC for all Congressional and Presidential level inquiries

TYPES OF COMPLAINTS

- Violations of DoD and AF standards, policies, or programs to include:
 - Fraud, Waste, and Abuse (FWA)
 - Reprisal
 - Restriction
- Higher Level Taskings
 - Presidential Inquiries
 - Congressional Inquiries
 - Higher HQ Inquiries
 - AF/MAJCOM Special Interest Items

COMPLAINT RESOLUTION

- Options for Filing a Complaint
 - Stop by office
 - Fill out AF IMT 102
 - Call to make an appointment
 - Leave message on hotline
- Provide as much information as possible (chronology of events, witnesses, evidence, etc.)
- Anonymity maintained if desired
