Air Force Instruction (AFI 34-219), 17 October 2007, is supplemented as follows: This supplement applies to all units assigned to Holloman AFB, NM. Commanders will give this supplement wide dissemination to apprise personnel under their jurisdiction of the procedures contained herein, the necessity of compliance and the consequence of noncompliance. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with (IAW) Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of in accordance with Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) located at <https://www.my.af.mil/afirms/afirms/afirms/rims.cfm>. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) using AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*, to 49th Force Support Squadron Sustainment Services Flight Clubs (49 FSS/FSVC), 280 First Street, Holloman AFB, NM 88330-8273.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This change implements new guidance that clarifies the authorized locations for on-premise consumption as well as the authority for dispensing alcohol. A margin bar (|) indicates newly revised material.

1.3.1.1. **(Added)** In accordance with New Mexico State law, military members, dependents, and other civilians must be at least 21 years of age to purchase, possess, be served, or consume alcoholic beverages. Under no circumstances will alcoholic beverages be served to underage individuals.

1.3.2.1. **(Added)** IAW New Mexico State law, 19 years of age is the minimum age for someone to serve alcohol. A 19-year-old may serve alcohol under restaurant conditions, after verifying the age of the patron. A 19-year-old may not serve alcohol in the bar or be employed as a bartender.

1.5.4. **(Added)** Persons creating an unfavorable incident at any Force Support or Army and Air Force Exchange Service (AAFES) facility as a result of overindulgence in alcoholic beverages will have their patronage privileges suspended for one year. Requests for reinstatement of privileges will be made in writing to the 49th Mission Support Group Commander (49 MSG/CC).

2.1.6.1. **(Added)** The 49th Force Support Squadron (49 FSS) and AAFES are the only authorized agents to sell and dispense alcoholic beverages on Holloman AFB.

2.1.6.2. **(Added)** Holloman's Clubs, Golf Course, Bowling Center, Base Theater, and Lodging may sell alcoholic beverages by the drink, for on-premise consumption, during their individual approved hours of operation.

2.1.6.3. **(Added)** The 49 FSS will be the only source of selling and dispensing alcoholic beverages for on-premise consumption during special events in, or catered by, a 49 FSS facility such as wedding parties, unit functions, private parties, etc. When possible, underage patrons will not be permitted in the same area where alcohol is being served.

2.1.6.4. **(Added)** Steinhoff and Heritage parks, 49 FSS athletic fields, FAMCAMP, equestrian facility, base housing, dormitories, dormitory picnic areas, unit picnic areas, Lodging, lodging picnic areas, and other areas approved in writing by the 49 MSG/CC are authorized areas for the consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons of legal age. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at the 49 FSS Apache Sports Range.

2.1.6.5. **(Added)** Alcoholic beverages may be consumed at base special events such as Independence Day, Oktoberfest, Open Houses, concerts, etc. with 49 MSG/CC approval.
