AFMAN 23-110, Vol 2, Part 2, Chap 24, is supplemented as follows:

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision adds “The Flightline Service Center Element” in paragraph **24.13.**; deletes paragraph 24.19.1.; supplements paragraph 24.19.2.; and changes paragraph **24.38.** to read “Buildup Supply points will be operated by Maintenance.” A bar (|) indicates new or revised material since previous edition.

24.13. The Flightline Service Center Element will be the turn-in point for all DIFM assets including Found On Base (FOB) items. Property turned in to the Flightline Service Center Element will have the following: Two Material Condition Tags/Labels, a copy of DD Form 1348-1, *DOD Single Line Item Release/Receipt Document*, issue/due-out release document or the SATS ID label, reusable container or AF Form 451, *Request for Packaging Service*, AFTO Form 350, *Repairable Item Processing Tag*, if required, and AFTO Form 20, *Caution and Inspection Record*, if required, or appropriate historical data record.

24.29.2. The property and turn-in document will be delivered to the Flightline Service Center Element for turn in processing.

24.38. Buildup Supply points will be operated by Maintenance.
