This instruction implements Title 42, Public Health, *Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments*, and AFD 48-1, *Aerospace Medical Program*. It prescribes the use of Maxwell AFB IMT 365, *Laboratory Test Requisition*. This instruction requires collecting and maintaining information protected by the Privacy Act of 1974 authorized by 10 U.S.C. 55, 10 U.S.C. 8013 and E.O. 9397. System of records notice FO44 AF SG E, *Medical Record System*, applies. Maintain all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication in accordance with AFMAN 33-363, *Management of Records*, and dispose of them in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) (available at <https://www.my.af.mil/gcss-af61/afirms/afirms>). This instruction applies to all personnel authorized to request 42d Medical Group laboratory services.

1. Personnel needing laboratory services who do not have Computerized Health Care Services (CHCS) access use MAFB IMT 365, *Laboratory Test Requisition*, to request services.
2. The provider indicates priority by checking the appropriate block at the top of the IMT, completes the patient identification information, and indicates the required services by checking the appropriate blocks. Annotate any comments or special requirements in the space provided on the reverse side. Providers must sign the request in order to receive services.
3. IMT prescribed: MAFB IMT 365, *Laboratory Test Requisition*.
