By Order of the Secretary of the Air Force, this Air Force Guidance Memorandum replaces AFGM 2014-33-01, *Senior Leader Secure Communications Modernization (SLSCM)*, dated 30 Apr 2014. Compliance with this Memorandum is mandatory. To the extent its directions are inconsistent with other Air Force publications, the information herein prevails, in accordance with AFI 33-360, *Publications and Forms Management*.

At the direction of the Department of Defense, Chief Information Officer, the Secretaries of the Military Departments will ensure senior leadership infrastructure, communication platforms, and equipment are interoperable with the SLSCM strategy and, as appropriate, support the integration of current and IP-based command and control (C2) systems. The Department of Defense, Chief Information Officer also directs the removal and replacement of current voice, video, and data capabilities with IP-based broadband capabilities that meet senior leadership operational requirements, within fixed and rotary aircraft, and ground mobile vehicles. For Air Force, that means ensuring fixed wing aircraft are equipped with wideband Satellite Communications (SATCOM) and addressing equipment issues to enable IP-based voice, data, and Video Teleconferencing (VTC) that will meet senior leader operational requirements. Removal of legacy equipment will be considered after leadership requirements are met.

Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) located in the Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS).

This Memorandum becomes void after one year has elapsed from the date of this Memorandum, or upon release of an Air Force publication incorporating this guidance, whichever is earlier.
