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This supplement implements and extends the guidance of Air Force Instruction (AFI) 34-219, Alcoholic Beverage Program, 04 Feb 2015. It applies to all Air Force units and members assigned to or tenants on Vance AFB. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, Management of Records, and are disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Air Force Records Disposition Schedule (RDS). This Instruction requires the collection and or maintenance of information protected by the Privacy Act of 1974 authorized by 10 U. S.C. 8013, Secretary of the Air Force; Air Force Instruction 31-203, Security Forces Management Information System; and E.O. 9397 (SSN), as amended. (AF Form 847 is prescribed in AFI 11-215, USAF Flight Manuals Program [FMP]. Refer to that publication for guidance on filling out the form.)

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Changed OPR from 71 FSS/COR to 71 FSS/FSV and updated supplemented paragraph numbers to align with revised basic publication. Revised verbiage of paragraph 2.1.6.

AFI 34-219 is supplemented as follows:

1.4.1. The minimum age for the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is 21 years of age. The minimum age for selling alcoholic beverages is 21 years of age.

1.8.1.3. Hours when alcoholic beverages may be sold by the drink are as follows:

Bowling Center 7 days per week 1100 – 2100.

Lodging 7 days per week 24 hrs a day.

Vance AFB Collocated Club* Tuesday 1700-2000, Thursday 1700-2200, Friday 1700-0200, Saturday 1600-0200

(* The club manager is authorized to adjust these hours at the Vance AFB Collocated Club, depending on patronage, not to exceed 2400 on nights preceding a normal workday or 0200 hours otherwise.)

2.1. The Bowling Center snack bar may sell only beer and wine coolers, and only for consumption on the premises.

2.1.6. In addition to the Services areas, the consumption of alcoholic beverages on Vance AFB is permitted in the following areas:

Lodging rooms: Cherokee Lodge guest rooms, Temporary Lodging Facilities, and Distinguished Visitors Quarters.

Housing units: Family Housing, Enlisted dormitories, and Officer Quarters.

Outdoor recreational areas: Golf Driving Range, Base Park, and intramural sports fields (except when in use for youth activities).

Vance AFB work center facilities (indoors and immediate surroundings): Unit commanders and staff agency chiefs will determine rules governing consumption of alcohol in their assigned subordinate work centers. Unit commanders and staff agency chiefs deciding to authorize alcohol consumption in/around these facilities are responsible for establishing and enforcing adequate procedures to prevent possession and/or consumption of alcohol by persons under the legal drinking age, and to deter alcohol-related incidents connected to alcohol consumption in their work centers.

2.1.8. (**VANCEAFB**) A request to consume alcoholic beverages in areas other than those outlined in para 2.1.6. must be submitted to the 71 FTW/CC in memorandum format, as indicated in the attached sample memo. Commanders are responsible for ensuring the POC for the event is made aware of the age limit for consumption of alcoholic beverages and its enforcement. There will be an obvious physical and time division between a social event with alcoholic beverages and a unit's official function (e.g., holiday celebrations with alcoholic beverages will not be held in the duty section while the section is observing normal duty hours/providing service to other base personnel).
