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**(JBCHARLESTON) AFMAN 11-2C-17V2, C-17 Aircrew Evaluation Criteria, dated 4 August 2021 is supplemented as follows:** The purpose of this supplement is to identify 437th/315th Operations Group (OG) C-17A, *Standardization and Evaluation Procedures* and implement unit responsibilities established in AFMAN 11-2C-17V2, C-17, *Aircrew Evaluation Criteria*. All JB CHS C-17A aircrews will be familiar with and responsible for the contents of this supplement. This supplement applies to Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) units. It does not apply to Air National Guard (ANG) units. The 437th or 315th OG Commander (CC) is the waiver authority for this supplement. Waivers to this supplement and AFMAN 11-2C-17V2 must be coordinated through 437th/315th OG Standardization and Evaluation (OGV). Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with (IAW) AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule (RDS) located in the Air Force Records Management System. This publication is subject to the requirements of AFI 33-332, *Air Force Privacy and Civil Liberties Program* and DAFI 16-1403, *Controlled Unclassified Information*. Ensure all records containing Privacy Act/Personally Identifiable Information created as a result of processes in this publication is safeguarded, maintained and disposed of IAW AFI 33-332 & DAFI 16-1403. ## Chapter 4

### LOCAL PROCEDURES

4.1. **General.** Use this chapter to define local evaluation criteria, as required.

4.2. **(Added) Testing Requirements.** All requisite testing should be completed before administering the evaluation. (Exception to this may be approved by unit Standardization and Evaluation (CCV Chief))

4.3. **(Added) Emergency Procedure Evaluations (EPE).** All C-17A evaluations will include an EPE. The EPE for the evaluation will be commensurate with the examinee's qualification and experience level. Instructor-qualified examinees will be evaluated on instructor ability during the pre/post-brief and/or during an appropriate portion of the flight.

4.4. **(Added) Special Interest Items (SIIs).** Examiners will evaluate identified SIIs on all evaluations. Applicable SIIs are identified in the Flight Crew Information File (FCIF) Library.

4.5. **(Added) Unit-Specific Pilot Evaluation Areas.**

4.5.2. **(Added)** Area 44, Special Interest Items.

4.5.2.1. **(Added)** Q - Satisfactorily demonstrated/explained knowledge of MAJCOM and/or unit special interest items IAW the guidance contained in applicable publications or FCIFs.

4.5.2.2. **(Added)** Q - Marginal knowledge of MAJCOM and/or unit special interest items IAW applicable publications or FCIFs.

4.5.2.3. **(Added)** U - Unsatisfactory knowledge of MAJCOM and/or unit special interest items IAW applicable publications or FCIFs.

4.6. **(Added) Unit-Specific Loadmaster Evaluation Areas.**

4.6.1. **(Added)** Area 49, Special Interest Items.

4.6.1.1. **(Added)** Q - Satisfactorily demonstrated/explained knowledge of MAJCOM and/or unit special interest items IAW the guidance contained in applicable publications or FCIFs.

4.6.1.2. **(Added)** Q - Marginal knowledge of MAJCOM and/or unit special interest items IAW applicable publications or FCIFs.

4.6.1.3. **(Added)** U - Unsatisfactory knowledge of MAJCOM and/or unit special interest items IAW applicable publications or FCIFs.
