

Sexual Assault Reporting Options

If you are sexually assaulted, make sure you understand your reporting choices:

Restricted Report

- Confidential
- NO police or Chain of Command involvement
- Victim must first contact:
 - Sexual Assault Response Coordinator or Victim Advocate
 - Healthcare professional
 - Chaplain

*Restricted option is not guaranteed if others, besides those listed above, know about the incident.

*Never delay necessary emergency medical care.

*May change restricted report to unrestricted.

Unrestricted Report

- Information shared only on a *need-to-know* basis
- Investigation initiated
- Response Team will be notified:
 - Medical and Law Enforcement
 - SARC, Victim Advocate
 - Chain of Command

*Once unrestricted, no option to make restricted.
