This publication supplements Department of the Air Force Instruction (DAFI) 34-107, *Alcoholic Beverage Program*. This supplement applies to all personnel assigned, attached, or associated to the 51st Fighter Wing (51 FW). Ensure all records generated as a result of processes prescribed in this publication adhere to Air Force Instruction (AFI) 33-322, Records Management and Information Governance Program, and are disposed in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule, which is located in the Air Force Records Information Management System. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the office of primary responsibility (OPR) using the DAF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command.

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

This document has been revised and should be completely reviewed. The parent publication, AFI34-219 was superseded by DAFI34-107 on 5 July 2023. Changes include paragraphs 4.1., Table 4.1., and 4.2.

**2.6.** Both Republic of Korea (ROK) and United States (US) military members, US civilian and USFK Korean employees, dependents of US Military members and 00US civilian employees, US and invited civilian contractors, military retirees, ROK military personnel assigned to Combined Forces Command (CFC) and United States Forces Korea (USFK) Koran employees at USFK installations who have reached their 21st birthday may purchase, possess, or consume alcoholic beverages on Osan Air Base (AB).

**4.1.** Facilities listed in Table 4.1 are authorized to sell alcoholic beverages to adults age 21 or older by the drink or in single-serving containers for on-premises consumption. Prior to the completion of the sale, the server will open all beverage containers. Patrons will be reminded that no containers will be removed from the premises. Delivery orders are limited to three beers per order.

4.1.2. The Osan Lodging Fund is authorized to sell distilled spirit miniatures, beer, wine coolers and other premixed alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption in all lodging facilities.

**4.2.** Open containers of alcoholic beverages will not be carried or consumed in public areas at Osan AB or the local community except at: 51st Force Support Squadron (51 FSS) picnic areas, the golf course, outdoor athletic events, areas immediately adjacent to living quarters, or at special events sponsored by 51 FSS conducted outside aforementioned activities.
