This instruction describes the proper completion and submission of 59th Medical Wing (MDW) Form 17, *Wilford Hall Ambulatory Surgical Center Cardiac Imaging Patient Intake*. This instruction applies to all personnel assigned, attached or under contract to the 59th Medical Wing. This instruction does not apply to the Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility using the AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with (IAW) Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of IAW Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS).

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

59 MDWI 44-116 has been revised. Changes include 59 MDW Form 17 title change and updated responsibilities.

**1. Overview.** The purpose of 59 MDW Form 17 is to document screening assessments on patients scheduled for a Computed Tomography Angiography and Coronary Artery Calcium Score procedure.

**2. Personnel Responsibilities.** Cardiology clinic and Radiology department use the 59 MDW Form 17. The physicians, registered nurses, licensed vocational nurses, medical technicians, and administrative clerks ensure that all patients scheduled for a Computed Tomography Angiography and Coronary Artery Calcium Score receive 59 MDW Form 17 to complete on arrival. The physician, registered and/or licensed vocational nurses, medical technician, and clerk personnel are responsible to ensure 59 MDW Form 17 is filled out completely and accurately.

**3. Form Submission.** 59 MDW Form 17 is submitted to the Cardiology Clinic or Radiology Department staff and uploaded into the electronic medical record upon completion of the encounter.
