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This instruction implements AFPD 48-1, *Aerospace and Operational Medicine Enterprise*. It describes the proper completion and submission of 59th Medical Wing (MDW) Form 2510, *Lackland Behavioral Questionnaire*. This instruction applies to all personnel assigned, attached or under contract to the 59th Medical Wing. This instruction does not apply to the Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve. This publication requires the collection and/or maintenance of information protected by the Privacy Act of 1974 authorized by 10 U.S.C. 55, *Medical and Dental Care*, and E.O. 9397 (SSN). SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Updated 59 MDW Form 2510, Lackland Behavioral Questionnaire, MDWI number and approval authority.

- 1. Overview.** The purpose of the 59 MDW Form 2510 is to identify individuals with behavioral or mental health issues. Trainees who report the most significant problems on the questionnaire are seen for a follow-up interview.
- 2. Personnel Responsibilities.** The screening questionnaire will be administered by 559 THLS/SGPK, Psychology Research Service, to all recruits. Completing the 59 MDW Form 2510 is mandatory for all basic military training trainees and occurs during the first 72 hours of in-processing.
- 3. Forms Submission.** Completed 59 MDW Form 2510s are retained by 559 THLS/SGPK as part of the Biographical Evaluation and Screening of Trainees Program.
