SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION AND RESPONSE PLAN



The protection and care of our Airmen is my top priority. The Maxwell AFB SARC office supports the 908th Flying Training Wing. All sexual assaults must be reported through the SARC office. Sexual assault services are available to ALL Airmen 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

You are called to remember, in my wing, there is zero tolerance for sexual assault. Be aware of your own moral and personal biases. Be mindful of what you say and how you act. Be a leader who supports victims and ensure every Airmen receives the help they need.

The priorities are to provide necessary care and support to the victim of assault, ensure that allegations of sexual assault are referred to the appropriate investigatory agencies and provide initial notification of the incident to appropriate commanders. First things first, call SARC, so they can advise what is best for the victim. To report a sexual assault, call **334-953-SARC (7272)**.

Sexual assault is a serious problem within the Air Force that can affect any Airmen regardless of a person's gender, rank, race, religion, or sexual orientation. The 908th Flying Training Wing strongly believes that EVERY airmen deserves a safe and healthy environment to work, learn, and grow into a multi-capable airman where one is treated with dignity and respect. If you suspect there has been an assault, please provide help and support to the victim. See something, say something.
