I direct commanders to find an acceptable risk to achieve mission accomplishment. It is every airmen's responsibility to maximize our warfighting capabilities and to protect Airmen through the prevention of mishaps, injuries, and fatalities.

I expect commanders and supervisors to set the right safety culture in their organization and to support safety programs. This requires proactive supervision from leaders at all levels who are willing to be introspective and objective to identify and assess hazards in their organizations. The appropriate decision-maker must select and implement the controls at the right level to reduce or eliminate the risk of encountering the hazards. Everyone is responsible for applying sound Risk Management principles in all their activities. You are essential to the Air Force achieving its mission, indispensable to your purpose, and irreplaceable to your loved ones!
