- ❖ SAPR supports sexual assault/sexual harassment victims by providing information on reporting options, advocating for needs, connecting to care, and providing referrals to address any needs that may arise.

RESTRICTED REPORTING

- ❖ Confidential
- ❖ **No Investigation**
- ❖ Access to Support from: SARC/SAPR VA, Medical, Mental Health, Chaplain, Victims Counsel
- ❖ Can go Unrestricted
- ❖ Eligible for CATCH program

UNRESTRICTED REPORTING

- ❖ Command notified
- ❖ **Investigation by OSI**
- ❖ Access to support from: SARC/SAPR VA, Medical, Mental Health, Chaplain, Victims Counsel
- ❖ Can't go restricted
- ❖ Eligible for Expedited Transfer and Military Protective Order (MPO)
