By Order of the Secretary of the Air Force, AFI 31-218, *Motor Vehicle Supervision*, is re-designated Department of the Air Force (DAF) Instruction, and this DAF Guidance Memorandum (DAFGM) immediately changes DAFI 31-218. Compliance with this memorandum is mandatory. To the extent its direction is inconsistent with other DAF publications, the information herein prevails in accordance with DAFI 33-360, *Publications and Forms Management*.
