This mission directive implements DAFPD 38-1, *Manpower and Organization*, and defines the mission of the Air Force Sustainment Center (AFSC). This publication applies to all AFMC Regular Air Force. This publication does not apply to United States Space Force, Air Force Reserve, or Air National Guard units. Ensure all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule located in the Air Force Records Information Management System. SUMMARY OF CHANGES

The formatting of this document was updated to align with guidance in AFI 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*.

1. Mission. Air Force Sustainment Center (AFSC) delivers combat effects to Service components and combatant commanders through threat-informed sustainment and logistics readiness support for weapon systems. AFSC accomplishes the Center mission through nine primary subordinate organizations: Ogden Air Logistics Complex (ALC), Warner Robins ALC, Oklahoma City ALC,

72 Air Base Wing (ABW), 75 ABW, 78 ABW, 448 Supply Chain Management Wing (SCMW), 635 Supply Chain Operations Wing (SCOW) and AFSC Software Engineering Directorate (AFSC/SW).

2. Command. The AFSC Commander is responsible to the Commander, Air Force Materiel Command, for the administration, training, and readiness of assigned forces.

3. Responsibilities. The Commander, AFSC shall:

3.1. Support the sustainment of the Air Force nuclear enterprise through positive inventory control of nuclear items.

3.1.1. Provide oversight, control, monitoring and tracking for Nuclear Weapons Related Materiel (NWRM) within the USAF supply chain IAW provisions of AFI 20-110, *Nuclear Weapons-Related Materiel Management*, and 23 series USAF Supply directives.

3.2. Deliver combat capabilities for the immediate and long-term requirements of component and combatant commanders.

3.3. Serve the Air Force, supporting its commands for the readiness of Logistics and Sustainment activities around the world.

3.4. Advocate for the provisioning of logistics operations, supply chain risk management (SCRM), supply chain management, depot maintenance and modification, and development, security, and operations (DevSecOps).

3.5. Sustain joint, interagency operations, and foreign military sales partners in accordance with coordinated support agreements.

3.6. Support planning and sustain maintenance capabilities for operational readiness, to ensure timely, secure, and effective response to peacetime operations, mobilizations, national defense contingencies and other emergencies.
