SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been substantially revised to update the purpose, mission, signature and references.

1. Mission. The 310th Space Wing provides optimized, scalable combat ready forces delivering space power for faster, more lethal, more accurate effects every day, everywhere. The unit provides a single command and control structure of geographically separated AFRC Space units. Provides oversight and execution of the AFRC support/mission augmentation within the Space Control and Global Space Mission Operations mission areas. The units support the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration within the Department of Commerce, United States Space Command and the Joint Force Space Component as well as other Combatant Commands by providing Global Space Mission Operations and Space Control capabilities.

2. Command. The 310 Space Wing Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Tenth Numbered Air Force Commander.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the AFRC Space mission.
