This Mission Directive implements policy and guidance in Air Force Policy Directive AFPD 38-1, *Manpower and Organization*, and AFI 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*. It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of AFRC 307th Bomb Wing. This MD applies to individuals assigned to Headquarters Air Force Reserve Command. It does not apply to Regular Air Force, Space Force, or Air National Guard units. SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been substantially revised and needs to be completely reviewed. Major updates include updated purpose, signature block and references.

1. Mission. The 307th Bomb Wing provides administrative support and oversight of reserve B-52 and B-1 Bomber Squadrons.

1.1. Ensures assigned units are combat-ready trained, manned and equipped citizen airmen to maintain readiness for Nuclear Deterrence Operations mission. Provides oversight of missions such as nuclear deterrence and global strike operations - safe, secure, credible - to support the United States Military and allies, combatant commanders and Joint objectives.

1.2. Ensures assigned units are combat-ready trained, manned and equipped citizen airmen to maintain readiness for Global Precision Attack mission. Provides oversight of missions such as target at risk, across the air, land, and sea domains by performing precision strike and intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance support roles.

2. Command. The 307th Bomb Wing Commander:

2.1. Reports to the Tenth Air Force Commander.

2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.

3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the Nuclear Deterrence Operations and Global Precision Attack core functions/missions.
