SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been substantially revised to update the purpose and references.

1. Mission. Provide worldwide response with the E-3 Airborne Warning and Control System aircraft by providing mission-ready aircrews to support the E-3's all-altitude "deep look" surveillance, early warning, control and airborne management roles in a variety of tactical, strategic and special missions.

2. Command. The 970th Airborne Air Control Squadron Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander of the 513th Air Control Group.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the surveillance, warning and control of strategic, tactical and special missions.
