This Mission Directive implements guidance in AFI 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*. It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of the 920<sup>th</sup> Rescue Wing. This Mission Directive applies to individuals assigned to HQ AFRC and subordinate units. It does not apply to Regular Air Force, Space Force, or ANG units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with IAW AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Information Management System and Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the OPR using DAF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command. This publication may not be supplemented.

***SUMMARY OF CHANGES***

This publication has been substantially revised and needs to be completely reviewed. Major updates include purpose, mission, command, responsibilities, and references section changes.

**1. Mission.** Plan, lead, and conduct military rescue operations and missions to deny competitors and adversaries exploitation of isolated personnel. Provide command and control structure and oversight of specially trained citizen airmen (aircrews and support personnel) in the execution of

Combat Search and Rescue for Combatant Command Theater requirements and collateral missions such as civil search and rescue, emergency aeromedical evacuation, humanitarian relief, counterdrug activities, and support for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration flight operations and other missions as directed.

**2. Command.** The 920<sup>th</sup> Rescue Wing Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander of the Tenth Air Force.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.
- 2.3. The Wing Commander prepares and deploys combat ready forces in support of Presidential directives and Global, Geographical, and Functional Combatant Commands.

**3. Responsibilities.**

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the rescue mission.
- 3.3. Organize, train, and equip combat-ready forces for unilateral, multilateral, joint, and combined missions and operations spanning force application, force enhancement, and force sustainment.
- 3.4. Provide forces to supported Combatant Commands.
- 3.5. Develop and support cooperative measures with mission partners to facilitate report, locate, support, recover, and reintegrate activities of personnel recovery.
- 3.6. Conduct supported and supporting command actions for assigned combat and non-combat operations and missions.
- 3.7. Serve as lead wing for Air Force Reserve Guardian Angel, HH-60G/W, and HC-130J weapon systems.
- 3.8. Serve as a voting member on weapon system charters for Guardian Angel, HH-60G/W, and HC-130J systems.
