It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of Civil Engineer Flights (Command Staff Augmentation Team). This Mission Directive applies to individuals assigned to HQ AFRC. It does not apply to Regular Air Force, Space Force, or Air National Guard units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained IAW AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Information Management System and Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the OPR using DAF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Form 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command. Submit requests for waivers through the chain of command to the publication OPR for non-tiered compliance items. This publication may not be supplemented or further implemented or extended.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been revised to update the purpose and references section.

1. Mission. Civil Engineer Flights Command Staff Augmentation Teams provide command and control, operational planning, theater-level bed-down planning, infrastructure assessments, designs, and advanced construction management, in support of regional contingencies or natural disasters during wartime or stability operations. The Civil Engineer Flights Command Staff Augmentation Teams are designed to function at echelons above Wing level.

2. Command. The Civil Engineer Flights Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander, 622nd Civil Engineer Group.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the Civil Engineer Flights mission.
