**AEROMEDICAL STAGING
SQUADRONS**

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY

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This Mission Directive implements guidance in AFI 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*. It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of Aeromedical Staging Squadrons. This Mission Directive applies to individuals assigned to HQ AFRC. It does not apply to Regular Air Force, Space Force, or ANG units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with IAW AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Information Management System and Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the OPR using DAF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command. Submit requests for waivers through the chain of command to the publication OPR for non-tiered compliance items. This publication may not be supplemented or further implemented or extended.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This document has been substantially revised and needs to be completely reviewed. Major changes include update to the purpose, mission, and attachment and references.

1. Mission: Trains to provide a level of capability sufficient to ensure appropriate supportive and emergency care for patients transiting the Enroute Care system, including aeromedical evacuation. Additionally, select Aeromedical Staging Squadron units will execute a comprehensive operational sustainment program via implementation of the six core elements of the Aerospace Medicine Enterprise as outlined in AFPD 48-1, *Aerospace Medicine Enterprise*, in support of the parent wing's mission until directed otherwise by competent authority.

2. Command. The Aeromedical Staging Squadron Commander:

2.1. Reports to the Commander of the Medical Group or assigned Wing when a medical group is not required.

2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel and assigned units.

3. Responsibilities.

3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.

3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the Aeromedical Staging Squadron mission.
