- 1. Mission:** The 426th Cyberspace Operations Squadron monitors, secures, and protects Air Force and U.S. Central Command global networks; ensures network integrity, reliability, availability, and confidentiality; and responds to hostile network threats and attacks.
- 2. Command.** The 426th Cyberspace Operations Squadron Commander:
 - 2.1. Reports to their assigned 960th Cyberspace Operations Group Commander.
 - 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.

3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the cyberspace operations mission.
