**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

This publication has been revised to update the purpose and the references section.

**1. Mission.** The 919<sup>th</sup> Special Operations Wing is the parent organization responsible for administrative support and training of all assigned special operations citizen airmen. Provides oversight and execution of the reserve special operations personnel assigned to support Special Operations Command requirements for operations and maintenance personnel to include the Aviation Foreign Internal Defense Combat Aviation Advisor, Remotely Piloted Aircraft and Non-Standard Aviation. The wing provides trained personnel to support Combatant Commander requirements relating to security forces, civil engineering, communications, logistics, supply, transportation, services and personnel functions.

**2. Command.** The 919<sup>th</sup> Special Operations Wing Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Tenth Air Force CC.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

**3. Responsibilities.**

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the special operations mission.
