SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been substantially revised to update the purpose, signature block and attachment and references.

1. Mission. Provides Airmen to conduct strategic inter/intra theater operations to meet Combatant Commander requirements. Provides operational aircraft ready to transport and deliver forces and materiel through the air. Perform passenger and cargo movement; combat employment

and resupply; aeromedical evacuation; and special operations support to achieve strategic, operational, and tactical-level objectives across the spectrum of conflict.

2. Command. The Strategic Airlift Squadron Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to their assigned Operations Group Commander.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in commander's AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the Strategic Airlift mission.
