**MEDICAL SQUADRONS**



**COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY**

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This mission directive implements policy and guidance in AFPD 38-1, *Manpower and Organization*, and AFI 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*. It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of the Air Force Reserve Medical Squadrons. This mission directive applies to individuals assigned to HQ AFRC. It does not apply to Regular Air Force, Space Force, or Air National Guard units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained IAW AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Information Management System Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the OPR using DAF 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command. This publication may not be supplemented at any level.

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

This publication has been revised to update the purpose, mission, commander and references section.

**1. Mission.** Provides trained citizen airmen medical personnel to accomplish the full spectrum of Aerospace Medicine, Flight and Operational Program, Occupational Health, and Force Health Readiness services as prescribed in AFI 48-101, *Aerospace Medicine Enterprise* for AFRC populations and regular Air Force active associated personnel to ensure an individual's medical requirements for deployment/contingency operations are met and current.

**2. Command.** The Medical Squadron Commander:

2.1. **Reports to the Medical Group Commander or to the Wing Commander where a Medical.** Group does not exist.

2.2. **Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.**

**3. Responsibilities.**

3.1. **Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities.***

3.2. **Provides oversight and execution of the medical mission.**
