**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

This publication has been revised to update the purpose, mission, responsibilities, and the references section.

**1. Mission.** Provides Department of Defense and joint leaders with directed imaginary capability in support of strategic, operational, and planning requirements during wartime, crises, contingencies, humanitarian operations and exercises. The 4th Combat Camera Squadron imagery provides a visual record for use in operational analysis, training, public information and as a

permanent historical record. It is a timely, accurate information resource, providing a "you-are-there" perspective, and is essential battlefield information in support of strategic, operational and tactical mission objectives.

**2. Command.** The 4th Combat Camera Squadron Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander of the 315th Operations Group.
- 2.2. The 4th Combat Camera Squadron Commander exercises administrative control over assigned forces.

**3. Responsibilities.**

- 3.1. Provides and ensures the training and readiness of assigned personnel.
- 3.2. Coordinates and communicates training, inspection and operational requirements with HQ AFRC Public Affairs functional managers.
- 3.3. Provides oversight and execution of the 4th Combat Camera Squadron mission.
- 3.4. Fulfills taskings directed by and/or coordinated with HQ AFRC Public Affairs.
