SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been substantially revised and needs to be completely reviewed. Major changes include purpose, mission and references section.

1. Mission: The Combat Communications Squadron provides communication infrastructure to establish and robust bare base using Theater Deployable Communications equipment which includes satellite communications radio, secure and non-secure voice/data circuits, intrabase communications, maintenance control, and system control functions. Establishes initial deployed

communications with tactical communications equipment. Provides connectivity for base infrastructure and from base infrastructure to theater infrastructure.

2. Command. The Combat Communications Squadron Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the 860th Cyberspace Operations Group.
- 2.2. The Combat Communications Squadron Commander exercises administrative control over assigned forces.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the Combat Communications Squadron mission.
