2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.

3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the C-5 Formal Training Unit mission.
