This Mission Directive implements guidance in Air Force Instruction (AFI) 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*. It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of Intelligence Squadrons. This Mission Directive applies to individuals assigned to Headquarters, Air Force Reserve Command (HQ AFRC). It does not apply to Regular Air Force (RegAF), Space Force (SF), or Air National Guard (ANG) units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with (IAW) AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Information Management System and Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) using Department of Air Force (DAF) Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command. Submit requests for waivers through the chain of command to the publication OPR for non-tiered compliance items. This publication may not be supplemented or further implemented or extended.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

1. Mission: Provides trained and ready Citizen airmen to produce timely, tailored intelligence products by synchronizing and integrating the activities of processing, exploitation, and

dissemination for analyzing tactical and national sensitive intelligence data in support of Air Force and Joint Warfighters across Combatant Command Theaters.

2. Command. The Intelligence Squadrons Commander.

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander of the 655th Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance Group or the Commander of the 755th Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance Group.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.
- 2.3. Falls under 10th Air Force.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the intelligence mission.
