SUMMARY OF CHANGES

1. Mission: The 954th Reserve Support Squadron serves as the Air Force Element of the Joint Transportation Reserve Unit within United States Transportation Command. Provide expertise in global air transportation to assist United States Transportation Command in global air, land, and

sea transportation to meet national security objectives in peace and war by maintaining command and control of lift forces and logistical infrastructure, setting operational lift policy, providing crisis planning for force deployment and sustainment, and improving the common-user lift system.

2. Command. The 954th Reserve Support Squadron Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander, Twenty Second Air Force.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned forces.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the 954th Reserve Support Squadron mission.
