This mission directive implements guidance in AFI 38-101, *Manpower and Organization*. It delineates the mission, command relationships, and responsibilities of AFRC Operations Support Squadrons/Flights. This mission directive applies to individuals assigned to HQ AFRC and subordinate units. It does not apply to Regular Air Force, Space Force or Air National Guard units. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained IAW AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of IAW the Air Force Records Information Management System Records Disposition Schedule. Contact supporting records managers as required. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the OPR using DAF 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route DAF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional chain of command. This publication may not be supplemented at any level.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This publication has been substantially revised and needs to be completely reviewed. Major changes include updates to the purpose, signature block and references.

1. Mission. The Operations Support Squadron/Flight provides combat-ready support for cyber operations; airfield operations; current operations; space operations; intelligence; weapons and tactics; Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape; advanced programs; operational plans; Aircrew Flight Equipment; Combat Crew Communications and flight simulator training. Also, provides

timely and accurate operational resources and flight mission materials needed to project airpower in their area of responsibility.

2. Command. The Operations Support Squadron/Flight Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to their assigned Operations Group or Independent Group CC.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

3. Responsibilities.

- 3.1. Execute commander's responsibilities as outlined in AFI 1-2, *Commander's Responsibilities*.
- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the Operations Support mission.
