**SUMMARY OF CHANGES**

**1. Mission:** The 717<sup>th</sup> Information Operations Squadron integrates citizen airmen to conduct Initial Qualification Training for Air Force Cyberspace Defense, Air Force Intranet Control, Cyber Command and Control Mission System, Cyberspace Vulnerability Assessment/Hunter, Defensive Cyber Operations-Host Analysis, Defensive Cyber Operations-Network Analysis and Network Attack System.

**2. Command.** The 717th Information Operations Squadron Commander:

- 2.1. Reports to the Commander of their assigned 860<sup>th</sup> Cyberspace Operations Group.
- 2.2. Exercises administrative control over assigned personnel.

**3. Responsibilities.**

- 3.2. Provides oversight and execution of the 717th Information Operations Squadron mission.
