Applicant Rights & Responsibilities

- Recruiters are forbidden from engaging in any personal, intimate, or sexual relationships with prospective, applying, or training Air Force members. This includes dating, physical contact, and any communication suggesting such a relationship.
- Using position, rank or influence to pressure, threaten, or coerce a prospective/new Air Force member into a sexual relationship or exchange of favors is strictly prohibited.
- Personal social interactions with prospective/new Air Force members are prohibited.
- Lending, borrowing, or soliciting money/favors from prospective/new Air Force members is forbidden.
- Accepting personal goods from, providing/consuming alcohol with prospective/new Air Force members in an unofficial capacity is prohibited.
