This mission directive (MD) implements policy and guidance in Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 38-6, *Mission Directives*, Air Force Instruction (AFI) 38-601, *Format and Content of Mission Directives*, and AFI 38-101, *Air Force Organization*. This publication may not be supplemented or further implemented/extended. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) using Air Force (AF) Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route AF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional's chain of command. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained IAW Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, Management of Records, and disposed of IAW Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS). Upon mobilization, this mission directive also applies to AFSPC-gained Air National Guard (ANG) units and members under United States Code Title 10 status.

1. Mission. Provides command and control of space systems to deliver global combat effects.

2. Command. The Commander, 50 SW:

2.1. Reports to and operates under the policy and guidance of the 14th Air Force (AFSTRAT) Commander.

2.1.1. Under the Space Mission Force (SMF) construct, reports directly to Commander, Joint Force Space Component Command (JFSCC) as the Space Mission Wing Commander (SMW/CC).

2.2. Functions as Installation Commander of Schriever Air Force Base, Colorado.

3. Responsibilities. The Commander, 50 SW:

3.1. Directs and oversees planning and execution of combatant command (CCMD) space operations taskings.

3.2. Commands and controls the Air Force Satellite Control Network through development, publishing, and execution of the Network Tasking Order supporting 178+ U.S. Government and allied satellites.

3.3. Operates and maintains intelligence surveillance, and reconnaissance; position, navigation, and timing; space situational awareness; and military communications satellites. Additionally, 50 SW provides mission oversight of the Air Force's environmental monitoring satellites operated by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

3.4. Provides base support to over 8,000 wing and base personnel representing Army, Navy, Air Force, Reserve, and National Agency units.

3.5. Executes approval authority for Defensive Cyberspace Operations (DCO) actions on associated wing missions.

3.6. Supports OSD, SAF, HAF, USSTRATCOM, AFSPC and other government agencies on planning, tactical employment and resource requirements and considerations associated with assigned missions.
