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This instruction implements AFI 36-3209, *Separation and Retirement Procedures for Air National Guard and Air Reserve Members*. This instruction outlines the preparation and use of ARPC IMT 88, **Election of Options**.

This instruction includes a requirement to maintain, collect, use, or disseminate information subject to the Privacy Act of 1974. AUTHORITY: Title 10 U.S.C., Section 1168.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This revision rewords paragraph 2. for clarification and deletes the choice for members to find an assignment. This revision also changes Form to IMT. A bar (|) indicates a revision from the previous edition.

1. Reference. AFI 36-3209.

2. Purpose. ARPC IMT 88 is used as an attachment to the Inactive Status List Reserve Section (ISLRS) letters to members who have been in ISLRS over 3 years and must voluntarily resign their commission or be involuntarily discharged.

3. Procedures.

- 3.1. Reserve officers who have been in ISLRS over 3 years will receive a notice of proposed action with an attached ARPC IMT 88 to make their election.
- 3.2. If the completed form is not received the Reserve officer will receive a discharge order and honorable discharge certificate in approximately 90 days.
