- Serves as the installation subject matter expert (SME) for resilience program and activities, the Community Action Team (CAT) and the Community Action Board (CAB).
- **Community Action Team (CAT):** Comprised of installation and community helping agencies who meet monthly to gather, analyze and develop solutions on community issues related to resilience, quality of life, community needs and gaps in services.
- **Community Action Board (CAB):** Senior leader driven forum organized to identify and resolve quality of life issues impacting Total Force (TF) readiness. This forum promotes CAT initiatives and assists in the development and implementation of local solutions to support the TF. This board meets 4 times throughout the year.
