Communication Guidelines for Helping Victims of Sexual Assault:

• **MANDATORY REPORTERS:**

- Instructors
- MTLs
- 1st Sgt
- Commanders
- MFLC Counselors
- Security Forces

- Mandatory Reporters are **required**

to contact **AFOSI** and the SAPR staff when informed of sexual assault.

AFOSI will initiate an investigation regardless if the victim files an unrestricted report.

- **If you're a mandatory reporter** according to the list above, here is how you can still help:

-If you believe someone is about to disclose a sexual assault to you, **it's okay to stop them.**

- **Example of what to say:**

Let me stop you for a moment. I want you to know I'm here for you and ready to listen if you need help, but I don't want you to lose any options that may be available. If you think you might like to speak with the SAPR Office, before we continue this discussion, I can put you in touch with them immediately. Just know that if you disclose a sexual assault to me, I will have to report that assault to law enforcement.

- If a **friend** shares with you a sexual assault incident in which they were the victim, that conversation can stay between you and the victim. **However, the friend or the victim can call the SAPR office to get help without being required to file a restricted or unrestricted report.**
