This manual implements Defense Explosives Safety Regulation (DESR) 6055.09, Edition 1, and Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 91-2, Safety Programs. This manual establishes Air Force policy for explosives safety criteria, identifies hazards, and states safety precautions and rules when working with explosives.

Defense Explosives Safety Regulation (DESR) 6055.09_Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 91-201, Explosive Safety Standards_AFSOCSUP is supplemented as follows: This supplement applies to all 24 Special Operations Wing gained Air National Guard (ANG) and Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) personnel as well as contractor personnel and facilities involved in explosive operations. Ensure all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained IAW Air Force Instruction AFI 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Information Management System Records Disposition Schedule. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) using the Air Force (AF) Form 847, Recommendation for Change of Publication; route AF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate functional' s chain of command. This publication may be supplemented at any level, but all direct supplements must be routed to the OPR of this publication for coordination prior to certification and approval. Requests for waivers must be submitted to the OPR listed above for consideration and approval. The authorities to waive wing/unit level requirement in this publication are identified with a Tier ("T-0, T-1, T-2, or T-3") number following the compliance statement. Requests for waivers must be submitted through the chain of command to the

appropriate Tier waiver approval authority IAW DAFI 33-360, Publications and Forms Management, Table 1.1. Requests for waivers of non-tiered items must be processed through command channels to the publication OPR for consideration. Compliance with the attachments in this publication is mandatory. 24 SOW added material is indicated by “(ADDED)(24 SOW)” in bold font.

V1.E6.12.1.1. **(Added) (24 SOW)** Additional Duty Weapons Safety Representatives (ADWSR) will utilize the 24 SOW approved Weapons and Explosive OI template as the single weapons and explosive related operating instruction for the unit. ADWSR will upload signed unit Weapons and Explosive OI onto their squadron safety SharePoint folder. (T-3).

V5.E3.2.10.6.2.2. **(Added) (24 SOW)** Primary duty 1Z (Special Warfare Airmen), 19Z (Special Warfare Officer), 3P0X1B (Combat Arms) and 3E8X0 (EOD) are the only AFSC’s authorized to provide training to unit personnel on activation of simulators, pyrotechnics and smoke producing munitions. Personnel conducting the training must have training certified and documented in their current training records. Completion of annual refresher training will be administered, documented and uploaded on to the unit’s safety SharePoint site by the ADWSR. (T-3).
