



**Get the help you need!**  
**Three reporting options are available.**  
Decide if you want the incident investigated and shared with your chain of command.  
**It's important to know the differences.**



## **Restricted**

Contact SAPR via Hotline or Office number

Command **IS NOT** notified - but may know

**NO** Investigation initiated

No Command support

SARC or SAPR VA attends to victim's needs and can provide support services if desired

Get medical care, counseling, and chaplain support

Get a Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE)

May be eligible for Victims' Counsel (VC)

Eligible for the CATCH program

Can change to an unrestricted report at any time

## **Unrestricted**

Contact SAPR via Hotline or Office number

Command **IS** notified

**AFOSI IS** notified and an Investigation may be initiated

Get Command support

SARC or SAPR VA attends to victim's needs and can provide support services if desired

Get medical care, counseling, and chaplain support

Get a Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE)

May be eligible for Victims' Counsel (VC)

May be eligible for CATCH in some situations

May request Military or Civilian Protective orders

Eligible to make an Expedited Transfer (ET) request

## **Independent Investigation or Third Party Report**

If you tell anyone about the sexual assault who subsequently notifies a mandatory reporter or AFOSI, or if someone knows about or observes the sexual assault and notifies command or AFOSI, an independent investigation may be initiated. If this happens, your reporting options may be limited and you may lose your restricted reporting option.
