This publication supplements Air Force Instruction (AFI) 34-219, *Alcoholic Beverage Program*. It applies to any unit, organization, group, person or persons to include but not limited to; 377th Air Base Wing (ABW) and associate units, active duty, reserve and retired military personnel, and Kirtland civilian Department of Defense (DoD) personnel and the sale, purchase, distribution, serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the installation. For the purpose of this supplement, installation of Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) refers to the entire confines of KAFB military reservation subject to the jurisdiction of the Commander (CC), 377 ABW. This publication applies to the Air Force Reserve Command (AFRC) if within the confines of KAFB. This publication applies to the Air National Guard (ANG) units/personnel if within the confines of KAFB. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) using the AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route AF Form 847s from the field through the appropriate functional's chain of command. This publication may not be supplemented or further implemented/extended. Requests for waivers must be submitted to the OPR listed above for consideration and approval. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with (IAW) Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 33-363, *Management of Records*, and disposed of IAW Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS).

### SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Removed any reference to unit heritage rooms. Removed Force Support Squadron (FSS) participation in or maintenance of any other organization's training records. Removed FSS from the approval of alcohol serve requests. Removed non sale hours for theater and added government facilities as approved by individual commanders to [Table 3.1](#).

3.1.2. **(KIRTLAND)** Individual unit commanders will maintain a record of all approved events filed IAW AFMAN 33-363, *Management of Records*.

3.2.1. There are no exceptions at KAFB.

3.2.3. There are no exceptions at KAFB.

3.3.2.1. **(KIRTLAND)** IAW the law of the State of New Mexico, the legal drinking age on KAFB is 21 years of age. A person under the age of 21 years of age shall not be employed as a bartender.

3.3.2.2. **(KIRTLAND)** Volunteers must be 21 years of age or older to serve alcohol.

3.7.6. Promotional, free tastings at the Mountain View Collocated Club (MVC) and it's patio area are authorized.

<b>Note 1:</b> In addition to the above, consumption of all categories of alcoholic beverages is authorized in government quarters, permanent-party quarters, and unaccompanied-personnel housing. Only beer, wine coolers, and other pre-mixed, commercially packaged alcoholic beverages with less than seven percent alcohol content by volume may be consumed at base picnic areas.							
<b>Note 2:</b> In picnic areas and not in parking areas, vehicles, etc.							

4.1. See **Table 3.1. (KIRTLAND)** for facilities and locations where the sale of alcoholic beverages is authorized.

4.1.1. No person will carry or transport any type of personally procured alcoholic beverages into the MVC and adjacent outdoor pool, bowling center, fitness centers, and into/onto the golf course. (Removed “and FSS athletic activities”).inserted fitness centers

4.2. See **Table 3.1. (KIRTLAND)** for facilities and locations where the consumption of alcohol is authorized.

4.3. Individual requests from unit commanders for consumption at ‘other functions or events’ should follow the 377th Air Base Wing Administrative Guide located at the ABW SharePoint site: <https://cs2.eis.af.mil/sites/12393/default.aspx>.

4.4. Prior to processing such requests for installation commander approval, the individual unit office OPR should contact the Force Support Squadron Community Services Flight (FSW) to obtain official coordination on FSS selling and or serving of alcohol.

4.9. KAFB is not currently under the Food Transformation Initiative also known as Food 2.0.

5.2.1. The installation commander approves the sale of beer, wine coolers and other commercially packaged alcoholic beverages with less than seven percent (7%) alcoholic content, by volume, for off-premises consumption by the MVC. Six-pack beer, wine coolers may be sold at the MVC when AAFES retail outlets are closed. The Class VI outlets can sell alcoholic beverages after 0600. Facilities listed at **Table 3.1 (KIRTLAND)** can sell and serve alcoholic beverages and alcohol, by the drink, as indicated. No person will sell, serve, or consume alcoholic beverages, e.g., distilled spirits, wine, malt beverages, or low-alcohol beverages (non-malt) on base except where authorized.

5.2.2. Customers may purchase keg beer for carry-out at the MVC during its operational hours.
