

Unauthorized Weapons

The following weapons are prohibited unless government/department issued:

- Any explosive weapons/materials (i.e., grenades, dynamite, fireworks, etc.)
- Switchblade knives or any type of knife with an automatic blade release
- Gravity knives (free-floating blade)
- Spring-loaded night sticks
- Firearm silencers
- Automatic Firearms
- Short barrel firearm, i.e:
 - any rifle with a barrel length less than 16 inches
 - a shotgun with a barrel length less than 18 inches
 - rifle or shotgun when the overall length of the weapon is less than 26 inches
- Homemade mortars, a.k.a. “tennis ball launchers” or “potato guns” or similar devices.
- Night sticks, black jacks, or saps
- Swords (excluding decorative display)

Personnel having illegal weapons are not authorized to bring them on base for any reason.

Carry of Concealed Weapons

-Only LEOSA-credentialed individuals can carry concealed within the confines of MAFB and transport/store their concealed privately-owned firearm (POF) for up to 24-hrs in privately owned vehicles (POV).

-Individuals must have their valid LEOSA credentials immediately available at all times when they have a POF in their POV or on their person while on MAFB. Acceptable LEOSA credentials are: AF Form 688D, AF Form 688E, AFOSI Form 59A, other Federal/State/Local Law Enforcement Officer Credentials.

-For a LEOSA credential to be valid, it must be accompanied by proof of weapons qualification within the last 12 months.

-LEOSA personnel must not be on a home-station or any local "Do Not Arm" rosters and will not conceal carry POFs, on their person, while in military/DAF police uniforms.

-Must register LEOSA qualification with the visitor's center to allow LEOSA identification in the DBIDS system, if remaining on the installation for greater than 30 days and concealed carrying POFs within the legal boundary of MAFB.

-LEOSA-credentialed personnel shall not carry a firearm while under the influence of alcohol or another intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance.

-LEOSA credential does not grant any authority to act on the AF or installation's behalf or to exercise any law enforcement authority.

Prohibited Carry Locations

-Any base medical facility, any Restricted Area, or any Controlled Area containing firearms, ammunition, explosives or funds. These areas will be identified by a restricted/controlled area sign and another sign or marker identifying that concealed POFs are not permitted in that area or facility. Exact locations can be found in 42 ABW Plan 31-101, *Integrated Defense Plan*.

Contact with Law Enforcement or Command Officials

-LEOSA-credentialed personnel stopped for base entry point checks, traffic violations, or for any other reason by law enforcement or command officials: must immediately inform those personnel that there is a concealed POF in the vehicle or on their person; must be able to produce their LEOSA credentials and proof of training; may be apprehended/detained for failure to inform law enforcement or command officials that they are carrying a concealed POF under LEOSA; may have their POF temporarily confiscated until they can produce LEOSA credentials.

Suspension of LEOSA Concealed Carry Authority

- The Installation Commander and/or the Defense Force Commander can restrict the carry or impose additional sanctions/controls for installation LEOSA concealed carry of POFs at any time.

- Individuals who violate any of these procedures may lose their privilege to carry a POF concealed on the installation or to store their POFs in their vehicle while on-base.
