This publication is Minot AFB Supplement 1 to Air Force Instruction 32-6000, *Housing Management*. It identifies Key and Essential positions and designated housing units for housing purposes. It applies to individuals filling positions identified by the 5 BW/CC. The authorities to waive wing/Space Force equivalent/unit level requirements in this publication are identified with a Tier (“T-0, T-1, T-2, T-3”) number following the compliance statement. See DAMAN90-161, Publications and Forms Management, for a description of the authorities associated with the Tier numbers. Submit requests for waivers through the chain of command to the appropriate Tier waiver approval authority, or alternately, to the requestor’s commander for non-tiered compliance items. Ensure that all records generated as a result of processes prescribed in this publication adheres to Air Force Instruction 33-322, Records Management and Information Governance Program, and are disposed of in accordance with the Air Force Records Disposition Schedule which is located in the Air Force Records Information Management System. This publication is new. Designates key and essential positions that are given priority in the assignment of privatized housing.

2.10.1.1. **(Added) Key/Essential Personnel and Designated Housing Units.** The following positions have been designated as Key and Essential by the Installation Commander as a condition of their employment. These positions are given priority in the assignment of privatized housing quarters, providing the incumbent possesses the basic requirement for such housing.
